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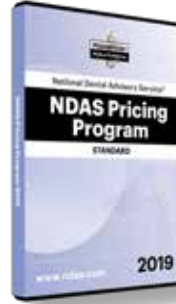

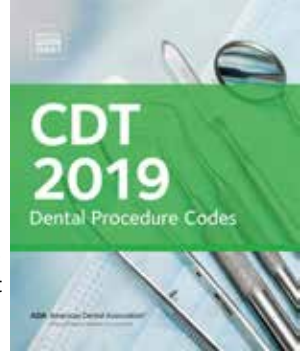


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CDT 2019: Dental Procedure Codes

CDT 2019: Dental Procedure Codes from the American Dental Association is critical for keeping current records and submitting accurate, effective insurance claims for reimbursement. The 2019 edition reflects 24 changes that go into effect January 1, 2019, and includes 15 new codes, 5 revised codes, and 4 deleted codes. 2019 changes include delivery of noon-opioid drugs for pain management, measuring and documenting glucose levels prior to a procedure, use of translation services, and more.
